### *Technical Rider*

### The Band

- Lisa Noe: lead vocals, acoustic rhythm guitar, percussion
- Pam Green: backup vocals, acoustic guitar, electric guitar and percussion
- Amy Black: backup vocals and drums

### Mics and Processing

Lisa: Sennheiser wireless or Shure beta 87C for vocals. Acoustic guitar via EFX pedals - 1/4" line out to PA

Pam: Shure beta 87C mic for vocals (phantom power required). Acoustic guitar, electric guitar and Roland Handsonic percussion all connect to her Roland keyboard amp - 1/4" line out of amp to PA.

Amy: Sennheiser wireless vocal mic or Shure Beta 58. Zen drum (electronic drum set on a stick) line out to amp. 1/4" line out from amp to PA.

Reverb/delay and EQ are usually a must. FMI, contact Pam Green at (727) 692-4852 (Stage Drawing available on request.)

### **Stage Monitor and Power Requirements**

Monitors: 2-3 monitors up front, as all performers are side by side at front of the stage

Power: Lisa and Pam use EFX pedals with their instruments that require power at the front of the stage.

### **Mixing Console**

- 3 mic inputs (vocals) – XLR
- 3 line inputs (instruments) – 1/4"
